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
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

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If the West had its Swinging Sixties, Hindi cinema had its Seventies. Everything that journalists today call 'retro' when referring to Bollywood (a term that came into currency only in the mid-1990s) is a product of the 1970s. But to refer to the decade as 'swinging' and 'retro' is missing the wood for the trees. The 1970s is the most influential decade of Hindi cinema. There we have said it. Not the 1950s, not the 1960s which unapologetic nostalgists hark back to. In the range and quality that the decade offered in terms of the art and craft of filmmaking, the music, fashion trends, the coexistence of commercial blockbusters with minimalist arthouse classics – the 1970s had it all.

The Swinging Seventies brings together a collection of essays that celebrate the myriad dimensions of this happening decade – the fashion, the music, the different genres of films, the iconic stars, the many moods and memories that have kept the decade alive in our collective consciousness. Put together by two film buffs who swear by the films of the decade – Nirupama Kotru and Shantanu Ray Chaudhuri – and including essays by almost every well-known name writing on Hindi cinema in India today, this is every film aficionado's gateway to a decade of cinema like no other.







मोहम्मद रफ़ी हिंदी फ़िल्म जगत के सबसे लोकप्रिय पार्श्व गायकों में से एक थे। चार दशकों से अधिक विस्तृत करियर में रफ़ी ने कई अभिनेताओं, संगीत निर्देशकों और शैलियों के लिए अपनी आवाज दी।

छह फ़िल्मफ़ेयर पुरस्कार, एक राष्ट्रीय फ़िल्म पुरस्कार और 1967 में भारत सरकार

द्वारा तीसरे सर्वोच्च नागरिक पुरस्कार पद्म श्री से सम्मानित किए जाने के साथ रफ़ी ने बहुत सारे पुरस्कार और प्रशंसा प्राप्त की।

अमृतसर के पास कोटला सुल्तान सिंह नामक गाँव में 24 दिसम्बर 1924 को जन्मे मोहम्मद रफ़ी, हाजी अली मोहम्मद और अल्लारखी के छह बेटों में दूसरे सबसे छोटे थे। गाँव के एक भटकते फ़कीर के गीतों की गहराई से प्रेरित होकर गाना शुरू करने वाले रफ़ी के बड़े भाई मोहम्मद दीन के दोस्त अब्दुल हमीद ने रफ़ी की प्रतिभा को पहचाना और उन्हें गाने के लिए प्रोत्साहित किया। परिवार की अनुमित लेकर 1944 में दोनों बंबई पहुँचे, जहाँ से मोहम्मद रफ़ी ने अपने गायन से धीरे—धीरे पूरे देश का दिल जीत लिया।

रफ़ी का गायन रिकॉर्डिंग स्टूडियो तक ही सीमित नहीं था। उन्होंने दुनिया भर में 30 से अधिक स्थानों पर लाइव संगीत कार्यक्रमों में अपनी ईश्वर—प्रदत्त आवाज़ का जादू बिखेरा। सुजाता देव गणित, सांख्यिकी और अर्थशास्त्र में अकादिमक पृष्ठभूमि और मीडिया एवं मनोरंजन उद्योग में 20 वर्षों से अधिक के व्यापक अनुभव वाली एक उद्यमी हैं। उन्हें भारत का पहला आईपीटीवी उद्यम आरंभ करने का श्रेय दिया जाता है।





पंडित जी के द्वारा लिखी गई "द डिक्शनरी ऑफ़ हिन्दुस्तानी क्लासिकल म्यूज़िक" एक बहुत ही प्रशंसित पुस्तक है। यह पुस्तक उनके जीवनभर एकत्र किए गए संगीत से जुड़े शब्दों और शब्दावली का एक शब्दकोश है। पंडित जी हिंदी में 101 कविताओं के संग्रह "हंसा के बैन" के लेखक भी हैं।




मोहनदास करमचंद गाँधी


मोहनदास करमचंद गाँधी का जन्म 1869 में गुजरात के पोरबंदर में हुआ था। उन्होंने लंदन से वकालत की शिक्षा प्राप्त की। उन्होंने दिक्षण अफ्रीका में नस्लवाद के विरुद्ध आंदोलन करते हुए भारतीयों के अधिकारों के लिए लड़ाई लड़ी। 1915 में वे ब्रिटिश—नियंत्रित भारत में लौट आए, और स्वतंत्रता संग्राम में भाग लिया। गाँधी जी के नेतृत्व में, लाखों लोगों ने सिवनय अवज्ञा आंदोलन में शामिल होकर अहिंसा के माध्यम से बदलाव की माँग की। गाँधी जी किटनाइयों का सामना करते हुए भी अपने प्रिय सत्य और अहिंसा के सिद्धांतों को नहीं भूले। महात्मा गाँधी राष्ट्रवादी व्यक्तित्व थे जिन्होंने भारतीय स्वतंत्रता के लिए अतुलनीय संघर्ष किया और अंततः उनके प्रयासों के फलस्वरूप भारत को 1947 में स्वतंत्रता प्राप्त हुई। अपने सिद्धांतों के कारण उन्हें राष्ट्रियता की उपाधि दी गई।


The Authorised Biography AMITAVA NAG



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

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
A.R. Rahman:

along with co-authoring Mind Blogs 1.0, a book of contemporary conversations.


Asha Parekh The Hit Girl ASHA PAREKH with KHALID MOHAMED

documentaries, screened at international film festivals, showcase his multifaceted contributions to journalism and cinema.



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
Mohammed Rafi: Golden Voice Of The Silver Screen SUJATA DEV Foreword: DILIP KUMAR

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


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


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


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
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
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
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
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
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
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
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
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
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RAHUL AGARWAL with BHARATHI S. PRADHAN
